Day 3 – Innovation & Entrepreneurship: Workshop with startup case studies, innovation challenge launch.

Day 4 – Nature as Innovation Lab: Field trip to Prometheus Cave and Martvili Canyon; reflection and storytelling challenge.

Day 5 – Design Thinking Sprint: Team prototyping sessions, creativity and stakeholders, intercultural communication.

Day 6 – Strategic Change & AI: Workshops on change management, AI and digital transformation, final pitch prep.

Day 7 – Final Pitches & Farewell: Innovation pitch presentations, feedback, certification ceremony, farewell.

By participating in the Alte Summer School, you will engage in a week-long innovation challenge that combines design thinking and agile problem-solving with Georgia's stunning natural beauty. You'll explore Martvili Canyon and Prometheus Cave as immersive learning sites while gaining insights into AI, sustainability, and global leadership. This program will strengthen your intercultural communication and teamwork skills through nature-based mindfulness sessions, culminating in a final innovation pitch to peers and mentors. Most importantly, you'll build lifelong friendships in a supportive international community of changemakers.
